### **General Information:**

- If the pool becomes contaminated with fecal matter or any contaminant, it will be closed immediately to complete water treatment and testing.

- No private pool parties are permitted, unless you receive permission from the HOA Board. Contact [vp@charlestonbay.org](mailto:vp@charlestonbay.org) to submit a request.
- There is **NO LIFEGUARD** on duty; therefore, it is swim at your own risk.
- Please leave the pool area and pool restroom area neat, clean and tidy when you leave. Residents are responsible for properly disposing of all their trash.

### **Resident Rules of Conduct for the Pool Area**

- Homeowners have the authority and responsibility to enforce all pool rules to ensure the enjoyment and safety of all swimmers.
- Profanity and inappropriate or drunken behavior, especially in front of children, will not be tolerated in the pool area. Resident complaints will result in loss of pool key access.
- Please limit guests to five.
- Children under the age of 14 are not permitted at the pool unless accompanied and supervised by someone 18 or older.
- Please accompany all small children to the restrooms to ensure the toilets are flushed and excessive amounts of paper are not put in the toilets.
- Infants and toddlers still in diapers must wear swimming diapers or plastic diaper covers with elastic around the waist and legs.
- Residents must wear appropriate swim attire. No shorts, cut-offs, or street clothes are permitted in the water.
- No diving, running, boisterous, rough play or excessive splashing
- Radios, tape/CD players, etc. should have volumes kept at courteous levels
- Vandalizing of the pool or pool equipment will not be tolerated.
- Please close umbrellas when you leave the pool.
- No pets, bikes, skateboards or any other items that are not safe and not intended for water use

will be permitted in the fenced pool area.

- Absolutely no glass of any type (containers, bottles, dishes, etc.) in the pool area.
- Smoking will only be permitted in designated areas.
